Yesterday Lethbridge School Division advised you that the province decided to close all K-12 schools based on the recommendation of the chief medical officer of health.

Although students are at home, staff remain fully engaged with preparing for student learning in the new reality. Alberta Education has let school jurisdictions know that the province will be developing and communicating a "base level of service" and school jurisdictions will navigate what the delivery looks like. In other words, the province will let us know what the expectations are with respect to breadth of content, and staff will work collaboratively to determine the most effective way to support students. We anticipate that processes for student learning will be communicated and in place by early next week. Thank-you for your patience as our staff work toward connecting with students in a new way.
