Purchasing, Pick Up, & Registration

Please use SchoolCashOnline to purchase Grocery Cards during the purchasing time lines each month.

In-person ordering is not permitted.

- Grocery Card sales will open on SchoolCashOnline for one week each month (See 2021 Grocery Card Calendar).
- **Pick Up - As per School Policy any visitor into the building must wear a mask.**
- Students picking up on the parents behalf must have an email sent to laura.kerr@lethsd.ab.ca in order to do so.
- The SchoolCashOnline Grocery Card fee is listed as a public fee; have all your friends and family purchase on behalf of your student - simply have them put your students name in the "Who are you Purchasing this for? " field.

- *There is no guarantee that cards will be available for purchase throughout the entire year; should the inventory on hand be sold out, the item will become unavailable for purchase until stock is replenished.*

Funds Applications and Guidelines

- Participants can use his/her fundraising credit for fees that have been posted on student school SchoolCashOnline accounts only.
 - Funds accumulated in the grocery card fundraising account **can be used to pay for both curricular and extra curricular fee's**
 - It is the participant's obligation to inform in writing (via email) detailing how the grocery credits are to be transferred. You can do this by contacting **Laura Kerr, WCHS Business Support, laura.kerr@lethsd.ab.ca**
 - Account balances will be carried over to the following school year for participants who remain students at LCI. Balances can be transferred to a sibling, relative, or another individual for his/her continued fundraising. An email must be received by July 31 of the graduating school year to notify of the upcoming transfer. If a participant has paid for all his/her school based activities from his/her fundraising account and that participant is no longer an LCI student and does not wish to designate another individual to receive any balance of funds, then the remaining funds will be transferred to the LCI General Fund on July 31 of the graduating year.
 - There will be no cash payout of funds to individuals.
 - Please request any transfers prior to making payment towards qualified fees. Refunds will not be given from the fundraising monies.
 - Upon receiving his/her card(s), the purchaser takes sole responsibility for them.
 - **Once a card is purchased there will be no refunds or exchanges made.**

Rebate percentage will be subject to a 25% admin fee. You will receive 75% of the rebate.

The admin fee is the school portion of this fundraising activity.

The school portion will be used according to Policy 1005.6 with the Lethbridge School District 51

Eg. \$200 Safeway cards purchased X 0.05% = \$10 rebate your portion is \$7.50 (student credit), admin fee \$2.50
