Happy New Year and welcome back! We recognize this return to school brings a combination of excitement and nervousness. We will approach this return to school with kindness and care, recognizing the wide range of emotions and perspectives of our Churchill Family members. We are a learning community that cares for one another; this is an opportunity to demonstrate this once again. Work Hard. Be Kind.

Below is some important information about daily procedures at WCHS, please know more information will be released this weekend once the Alberta Government releases the updated Re-Entry Plan:

- Before coming to school, students will complete the new COVID-19 Screen Questionnaire (do not hand this in, it is a self-assessment). It is incredibly important that if students do not feel well, they stay at home. Please keep your child home if they have any symptoms (even if they test negative for COVID-19).
- Students, if you are ill or you are required to stay home, please ensure you stay in contact with your teachers.
- Students may enter the school through the front entrance, the PE entrance, or at the doors to the gravel parking lot.
- The doors will open at 7:45am.
- Please use the hand sanitizer provided at the entrances.
- Students are encouraged to hand sanitize throughout the day.
- Students are required to have a mask on when entering the school building and throughout the day.
- Masks must always be worn throughout the day. This is a change from our previous mask policy. The Alberta government has announced this masking policy is province wide.
- Masks must be worn by students and staff, except when eating or drinking.
- Masks will be worn in Physical Education classes when participating indoors. Our PE team will ensure activities are low aspiration activities.
- Choir masks will be worn during choir class.
- Band instrument covers and masks must be worn if student is not playing a wind instrument.
- Students will not be able to eat in common spaces (hallways, cafeteria, learning commons).
- The lunch break is scheduled from 11:30-12:15pm. If students stay at school for lunch, they will eat their lunch in your Mod 20 class from 11:30-11:45am. **We will no longer have the cafeteria open as an eating space.** Students are welcome to leave the school for lunch. We encourage our students to get outside in nature! Please eat outside if the weather is nice.
- Once students are done eating, they can leave their Mod 20 class and spend time in the hallways or outside (masks must be worn).
- The cafeteria continues to be a teaching space, students will not have access to the space during the school day.
- If students do not have a class, and are able to leave, we ask that they please head home for their spare.
