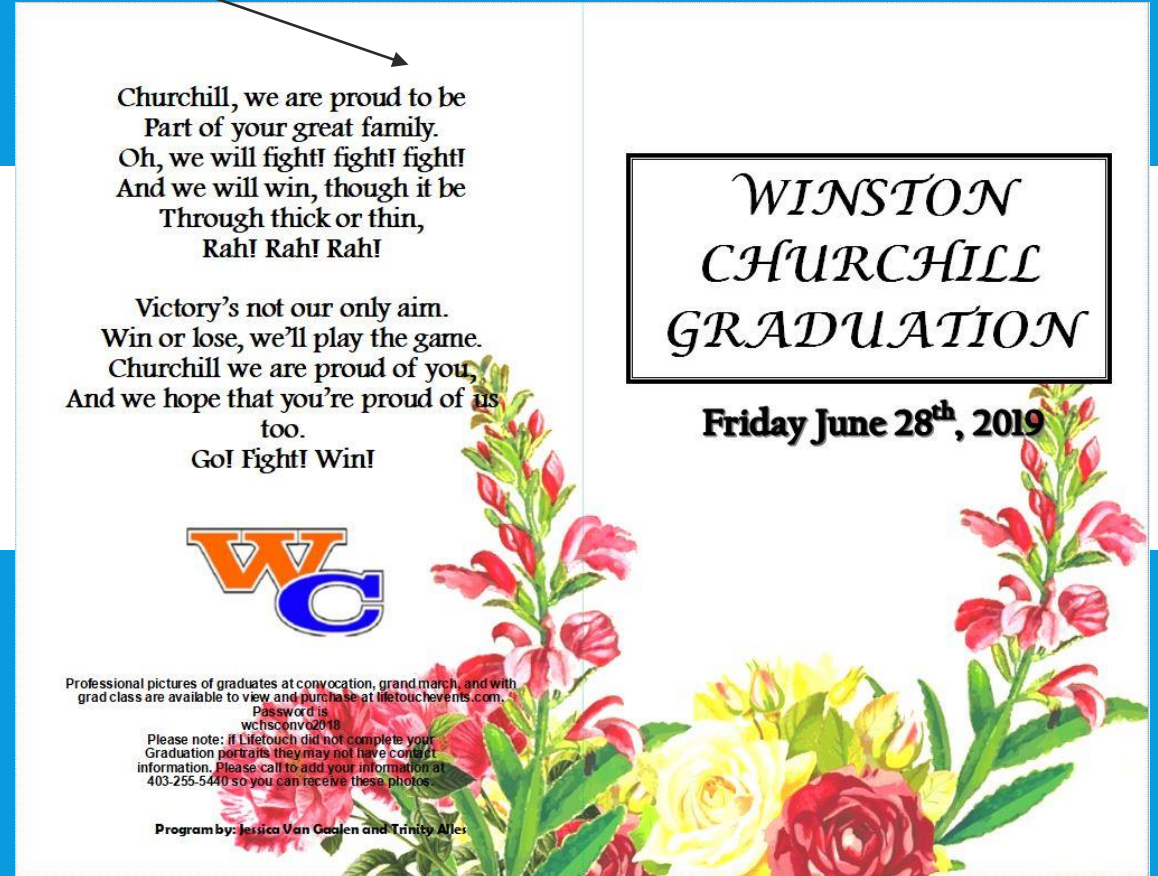

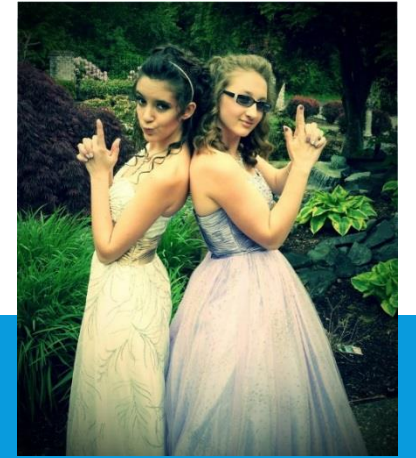

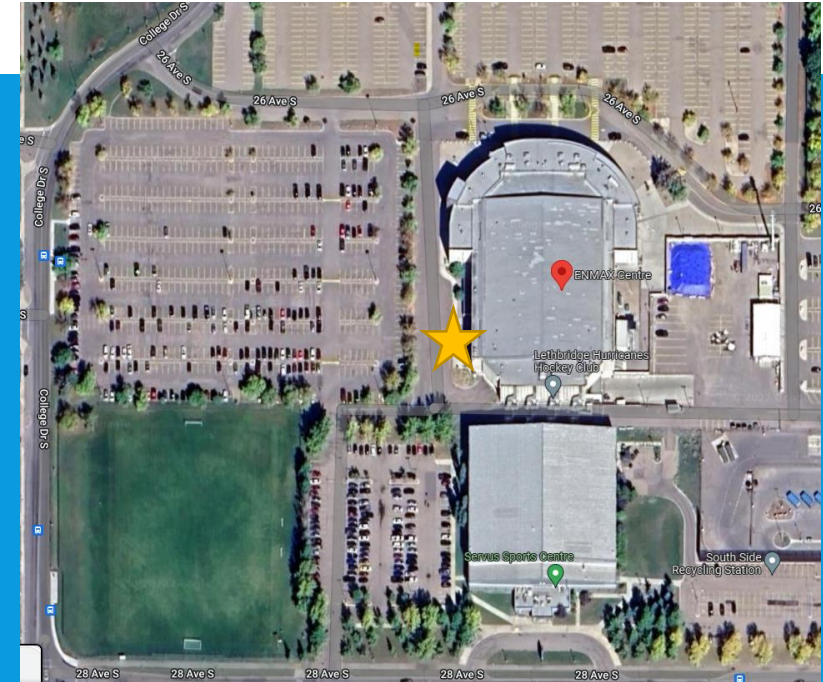


Stage setup



CONVOCAATION STARTS AT 10:00AM, BUT PLAN TO ARRIVE AT 9:00AM

- Please pay attention to signage. Free parking at Enmax.
- Bring CAP, GOWN & STOLE to the Enmax
- Come to the West Player's Entrance
- Dress light underneath – it will be warm!
- Arrive at 9:00 Find Advisor name on wall.
- Group photo at 9:30
- Back into hall in Advisor by alphabet. Be patient. There will be some standing around
- Time to file into area (ice surface) – follow the people ahead of you



CONVOCATION CONTINUED..

- Once in arena, staff will direct you to your seat
- Your name will be on a chair. Sit in that chair to remain in the order you will be called up in
- Pay attention to the teachers who will direct you by rows to leave your chairs and prepare to walk across the stage. You will return to your chairs after you leave the stage
- Walking across the stage (Demo) and “handshake photo” (Demo)
- You get to keep your cap and gown but you **MUST** return your stole as you leave the gym

EVENING CELEBRATION/RECEPTION

- Please pay attention to signage.
- Doors open at 6:00 Program begins at 6:30
- Open floor seating at tables are for GRADS ONLY (no dates)...8 to a table
- Program includes speeches
- Students will assemble BEHIND the stage, on the south side of the arena floors
- Staff will be there to direct you
- Staff member will provide you with a card with your information for walking across the stage...Grand Entrance...you walk across the stage, pose for photo, head to your table
- After 8:15pm, and once the floor is cleared, the dance will begin (explain dances, etc.)
- We hope you stay to dance!



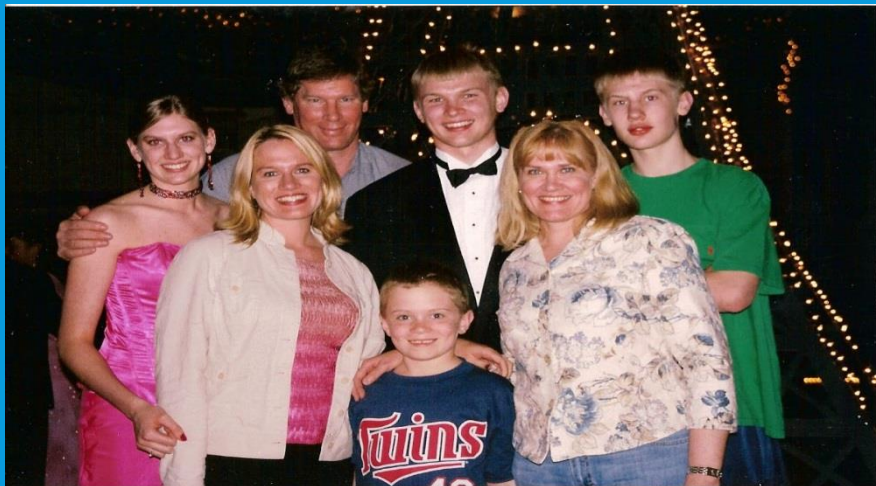

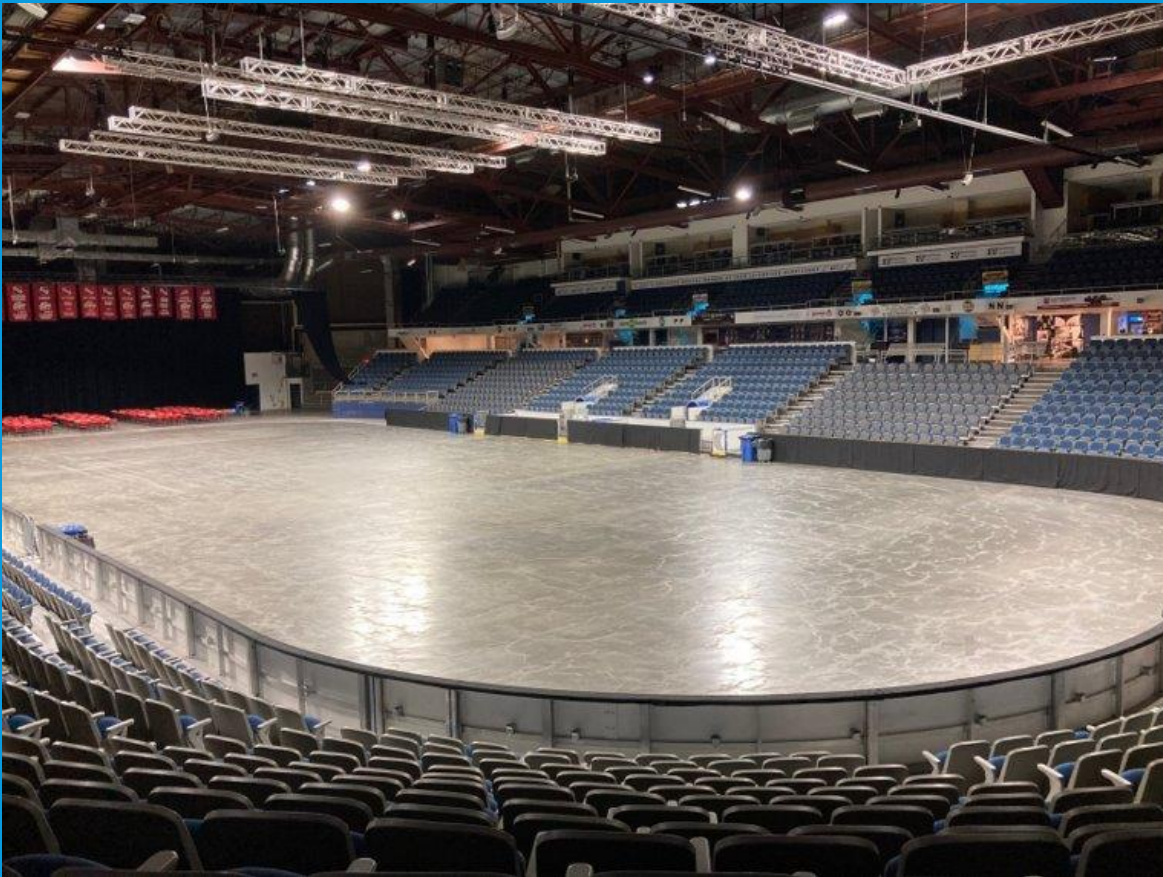
Convocation Set up from Stage looking out

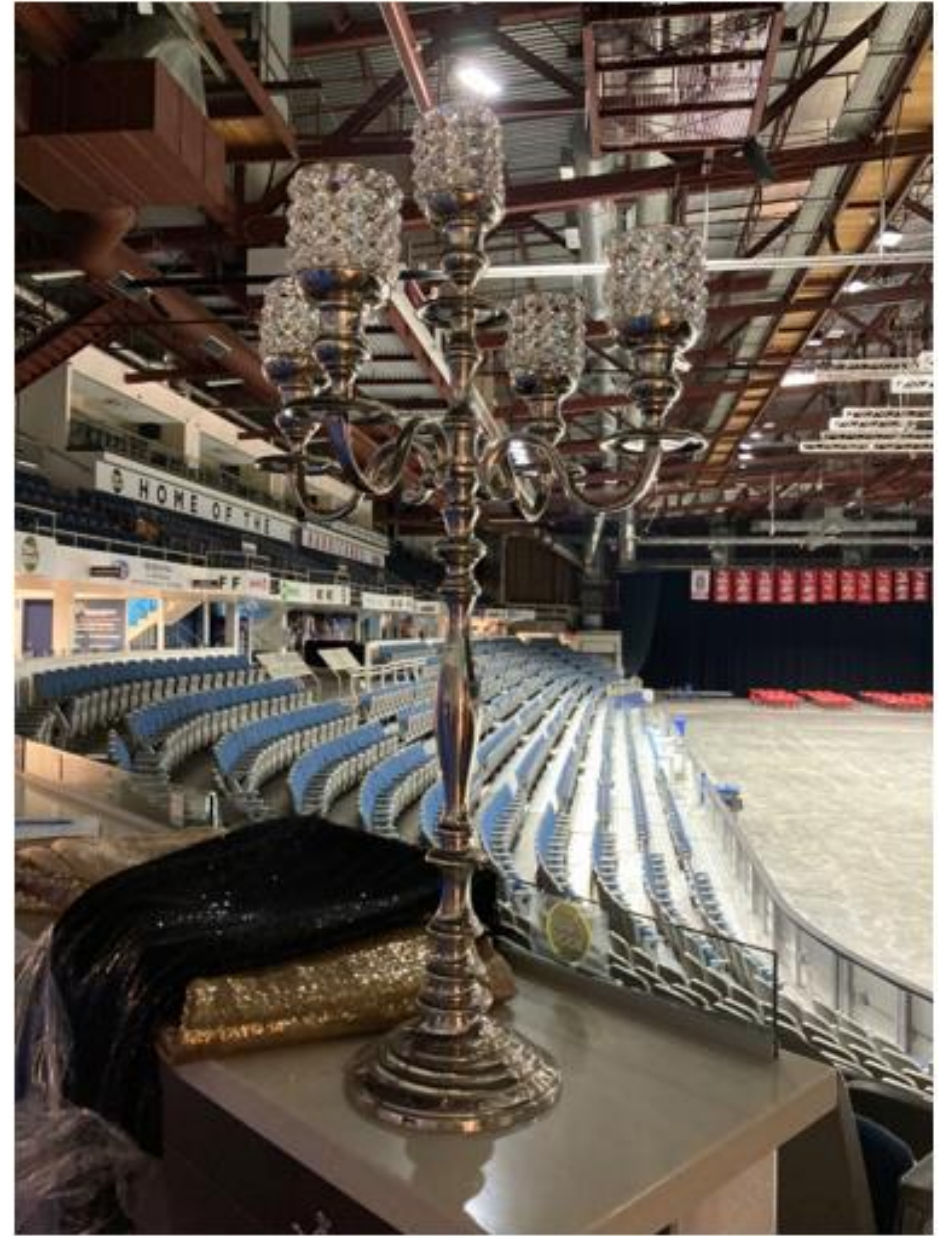
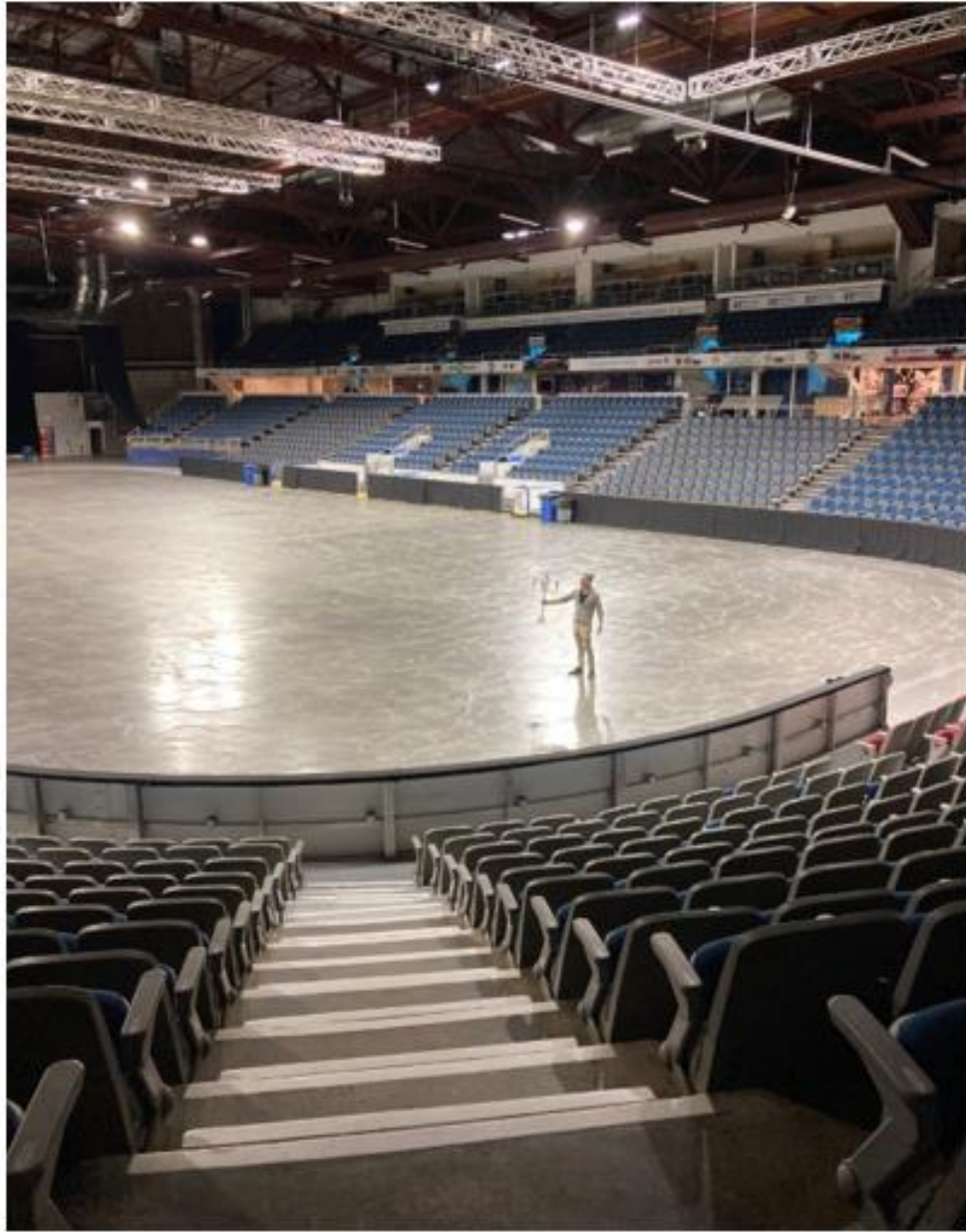


Evening Celebration Set up
