Interact works with its parent organization (Rotary International) to support students in pursuing to improve their community by setting on local and on global goal.

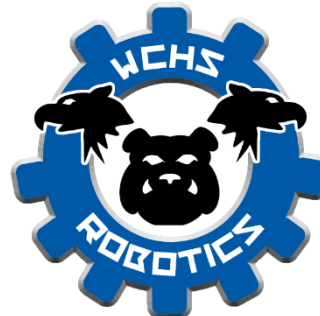
